6 AN ACT
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9 Relating to Colbert County; to authorize the county
10 board of education and the Muscle Shoals, Sheffield, and
11 Tuscumbia City Boards of Education to insure school buildings
12 and property under their jurisdiction either through the State
13 Insurance Fund or with a private insurance company.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

15 Section 1. In accordance with Section 41-15-1, Code of
16 Alabama 1975, the Colbert County Board of Education may insure
17 school buildings and property under the jurisdiction of the
18 board through the State Insurance Fund or with a private
19 insurance company, which in the opinion of the board, provides
20 the best coverage for the school buildings and property.

21 Section 2. In accordance with Section 41-15-1, Code of
22 Alabama 1975, the Muscle Shoals City Board of Education in
23 Colbert County may insure school buildings and property under
24 the jurisdiction of the board through the State Insurance Fund
25 or with a private insurance company, which in the opinion of
26 the board, provides the best coverage for the school buildings
27 and property.

28 Section 3. In accordance with Section 41-15-1, Code of



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Alabama 1975, the Sheffield City Board of Education in Colbert County may insure school buildings and property under the jurisdiction of the board through the State Insurance Fund or with a private insurance company, which in the opinion of the board, provides the best coverage for the school buildings and property.

Section 4. In accordance with Section 41-15-1, Code of Alabama 1975, the Tuscumbia City Board of Education in Colbert County may insure school buildings and property under the jurisdiction of the board through the State Insurance Fund or with a private insurance company, which in the opinion of the board, provides the best coverage for the school buildings and property.

Section 5. This act shall become effective on June 1, 2024.
