11 interscholastic quiz bowl competition in the United States;
12 national competitions are held in four states: Alabama,
13 Pennsylvania, Washington, and Wisconsin; and

14 WHEREAS, the teams, which represent public, private,
15 and charter high schools, compete throughout the season that
16 begins in January and culminates with a State Championship
17 tournament in March of every year; and

18 WHEREAS, quiz questions are comprised from a robust
19 group of educational topics that include Current Events,
20 American History, Biology, Sports, Literature, Mathematics,
21 Shakespeare, Geography, Chemistry, Art History, Physics,
22 American Government, and World History; and

23 WHEREAS, the Murphy High School Hi-Q Team has
24 demonstrated exceptional determination and persistence while
25 preparing for this year's state championship, which was held
26 on March 12, 2024; in a fierce competition that came down to
27 the last question, Murphy edged Alma Bryant High School by
28 one point and placed defending state champion Baker High
