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7 WHEREAS, highest commendations are extended to
8 Hackleburg Police Officer Zach Booth for his heroic and
9 lifesaving actions on February 27, 2024; and

10 WHEREAS, while on routine patrol around one o'clock
11 in the morning, Officer Zach Booth noticed a residence on
12 fire in the Crestview Heights neighborhood; his quick
13 actions saved the lives of the 72-year old homeowner, his
14 granddaughter, and her friend; and

15 WHEREAS, the outcome of the fire would have been much
16 different without the courageous actions of Officer Booth;
17 the residents of the home were sleeping and he was able to
18 wake them; he bravely entered the home and put the homeowner
19 into his wheelchair and brought him out unharmed, while the
20 girls exited on their own; and

21 WHEREAS, Officer Booth celebrated his one year
22 anniversary of being on the police force in January; he
23 graduated from Gordo High School, but has lived in Hamilton
24 for some time; he is also a veteran having served four years
25 in the United States Air Force; he is considering obtaining
26 cross-training with the fire department; now therefore,
