42 services and resources to cancer patients, the elderly, and
43 families facing financial hardship; Compassion
44 International, an organization dedicated to releasing
45 children from poverty worldwide; and the Manna House of
46 Huntsville, a local initiative involved in programs such as
47 providing meals for school children; and
