5 RETIREMENT FROM ALABAMA A&M UNIVERSITY.

7 WHEREAS, it is with profound appreciation and deepest
8 admiration that we recognize Dr. Lloyd Walker for 33 years
9 of steadfast service and leadership as a professor, dean,
10 and research director at Alabama A&M University; we also
11 take this opportunity to heartily congratulate him on the
12 momentous occasion of his retirement, effective January 1,
13 2026; and

14 WHEREAS, colleagues describe Dr. Walker's
15 contributions to reshaping the poultry industry as
16 foundational; however, he humbly credits his work with
17 students as remaining central to all his decisions; he
18 believes that real education means teaching students how to
19 use the knowledge that they have earned and learned; and

20 WHEREAS, Dr. Walker, a native of Port Morant in Saint
21 Thomas Parish, Jamaica, received Bachelor's and Master's
22 degrees from Prairie View A&M University in his home
23 country, as well as a Ph.D. from Texas A&M University in
24 College Station, Texas; his early research focused on how to
25 rapidly increase poultry production without the expense of
26 expanding aging facilities; he was a member of the team that
27 helped refine electrical stimulation techniques to
28 accelerate tenderization, moving poultry more efficiently

30 WHEREAS, at Alabama A&M, he taught chemistry and held
31 a variety of leadership roles including department chair,
32 interim associate provost, and dean; administrative
33 positions included the registrar's office, admissions,
34 University College, the State Black Archives, programs, and
35 eventually the Office of Sponsored Programs; in 2014, he
36 became Dean of the College of Agricultural, Life and Natural
37 Sciences and Director of 1890 Research; and

38 WHEREAS, Dr. Walker has been married for 44 years to
39 his lovely and accomplished wife, Faye, who retired from
40 Huntsville City Schools after a successful career of her
41 own; their son, Kibwe, who attained his biology degree from
42 Alabama A&M, now works as a regional training manager in
43 Virginia; daughter, Carol, has built a successful career of
44 her own; and youngest daughter, Karlene Walker-Shirley is a
45 pediatrician; in retirement, Dr. Walker looks forward to
46 spending time with all of them, as well as present and
47 future grandchildren; and

48 WHEREAS, other plans for the newly retired Dr. Walker
49 include remaining connected to Alabama A&M, as a teacher or
50 speaker when needed; continuing to write, specifically a
51 more student-friendly food chemistry text and a book
52 capturing the Jamaican sayings of his mother, Remella
53 Nesbeth; and traveling with Faye to new places they have not
