1 Enrolled, An Act,

3 Relating to multi-member boards; to authorize the  
4 Governor, the Lieutenant Governor, the Speaker of the House of  
5 Representatives, the President Pro Tempore of the Senate, the  
6 Minority Leader of the House of Representatives, and the  
7 Minority Leader of the Senate to remove and replace at any  
8 time any board member over which he or she has appointing  
9 authority in certain circumstances; and to provide exceptions.

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

11 Section 1. (a) As used in this section, "board" means  
12 any board, authority, or commission comprised of individual  
13 members, of which some or all members are appointed, as  
14 established under state law.

15 (b) Any individual appointed to a board by the  
16 Governor, the Lieutenant Governor, the Speaker of the House of  
17 Representatives, the President Pro Tempore of the Senate, the  
18 Minority Leader of the House of Representatives, or the  
19 Minority Leader of the Senate pursuant to a state law that  
20 authorizes the appointment shall serve at the pleasure of the  
21 Governor, the Speaker of the House, the President Pro Tempore  
22 of the Senate, the House Minority Leader, or the Senate  
23 Minority Leader, as the case may be.

24 (c) (1) Notwithstanding any law to the contrary,  
25 including any law providing a specific removal process, the  
26 Governor, the Lieutenant Governor, the Speaker of the House of  
27 Representatives, the President Pro Tempore of the Senate, the  
28 Minority Leader of the House of Representatives, and the

29 Minority Leader of the Senate, at any time, may remove any  
30 board member over which he or she has appointing authority.

31 (2) Any board member removed pursuant to subdivision  
32 (1) shall be replaced in accordance with existing law by the  
33 respective appointing authority, provided the new member meets  
34 the applicable qualifications to serve on the board, as set  
35 forth in the relevant state law.

36 (d) This section does not authorize the Governor to  
37 remove any individual whom the Governor previously appointed  
38 to fill a vacancy of an elected office.

39 (e) This section does not apply to the Alabama State  
40 Port Authority, the State Ethics Commission, or to the  
41 governing board of any two-year or four-year public  
42 institution of higher education.

43 Section 2. This act shall become effective on October  
44 1, 2026.
