A BILL

TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

Relating to Limestone County; amend Section

45-42-110.01, Code of Alabama 1975; to remove the limit placed on the additional expense allowance provided to members of the board of registrars; to authorize the county commission to set the amount of the additional expense allowance by resolution.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Section 45-42-110.01, Code of Alabama 1975, is amended to read as follows:

"§45-42-110.01

~~(a) This section shall apply only to Limestone County.~~

~~(b)~~ (a) (1) Each member of the Limestone County Board of

Registrars shall be entitled to receive an additional expense allowance ~~in the amount of fifteen dollars (\$15) per day of an~~ amount established by the county commission through

resolution, for each day when the board is authorized to meet and conduct business. The county commission may change or amend the amount of the allowance through passing a subsequent

resolution. The expense allowance provided for in this

~~section~~subsection shall be in addition to any and all other compensation, salary, and expense allowance provided by law

29 and shall be paid out of the county general fund.

30 ~~(c)(2)~~ The operation of this ~~section~~subsection shall be
31 retroactive to October 1, 2001, and all actions and payments
32 made to the board on and after that date are hereby ratified
33 and confirmed.

34 (b) Beginning on the effective date of this act, the
35 Limestone County Commission shall establish, by resolution, an
36 expense allowance for members of the board of registrars in an
37 amount determined by the commission. This subsection
38 supersedes subsection (a), and on the effective date of this
39 act, the expense allowance in subsection (a) shall be void.
40 The expense allowance provided for in this subsection shall be
41 in addition to any and all other compensation, salary, and
42 expense allowance provided by law and shall be paid out of the
43 county general fund."

44 Section 2. This act shall become effective on October
45 1, 2026.
