9 Relating to Tuscaloosa County; to provide for annual
0 longevity pay to the sheriff, tax assessor, and tax collector
1 as provided to all active full-time regular employees of
2 Tuscaloosa County; and to require the Tuscaloosa County
3 Commission to provide for the amount and date of longevity
4 payments.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

16 Section 1. (a) Beginning June 1, 2026, the Tuscaloosa
17 County Sheriff shall be entitled to receive the same longevity
18 pay as provided to all active full-time regular employees in
19 the service of Tuscaloosa County.

23 (c) The Tuscaloosa County Commission shall provide for:

29 County Tax Assessor and the Tuscaloosa County Tax Collector
30 shall be entitled to receive the same longevity pay as
31 provided to all active full-time regular employees in the
32 service of Tuscaloosa County.

33 (b) The longevity pay available to the tax assessor and
34 tax collector shall be paid from the county general fund in
35 the same manner as all active full-time regular employees of
36 Tuscaloosa County.

37 (c) The Tuscaloosa County Commission shall provide for:

38 (1) The amount of longevity pay that the tax assessor
39 and tax collector receive; and

40 (2) The date on which the longevity payment will be
41 made to the tax assessor and tax collector.

42 Section 3. This act shall become effective on June 1,
43 2026.
