SYNOPSIS:

This bill would authorize public institutions of higher education to accept Classic Learning Test (CLT) scores to the same extent as American College Test (ACT) and Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT) scores for demonstrating college readiness and satisfying admissions criteria.

A BILL
TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

Relating to public institutions of higher education; to authorize the institutions to accept the Classic Learning Test (CLT) to the same extent the institution accepts the American College Test (ACT) and the Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT) for demonstrating college readiness and satisfying admissions criteria.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. A state-supported public institution of higher education may accept the Classic Learning Test (CLT) to the same extent the institution accepts the American College Test (ACT) and the Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT) for demonstrating college readiness and satisfying admissions
