4 TO MILE MARKER 41 IN MONROE COUNTY THE SPECIAL AGENT JUSTIN

7 WHEREAS, it is with the highest accolade that this  
8 body honors Special Agent Justin Jemel Williams by  
9 requesting the State Department of Transportation designate  
10 the portion of Alabama Highway 21 from mile marker 39 to  
11 mile marker 41 in Monroe County, Alabama, the Special Agent  
12 Justin Williams Memorial Highway; and

13 WHEREAS, Special Agent Williams distinguished himself  
14 in the Highway Patrol Division of the Alabama State Law  
15 Enforcement Agency (ALEA); after three years with the State  
16 Troopers, he was advanced to the Major Crimes Division in  
17 the ABI/SBI branch of ALEA, serving five years with that  
18 agency and tackling complex criminal investigations; he was  
19 assigned to the United States Marshals Fugitive Apprehension  
20 Task Force, showcasing his ability to collaborate on a  
21 national level; he then served six years in protective  
22 services, serving on the protective details of both Governor  
23 Robert Bentley and Governor Kay Ivey, where he further  
24 distinguished himself in a role that required a high level  
25 of skill to manage often high-stress situations; and

26 WHEREAS, Special Agent Williams' dedication to law  
27 enforcement is evident in his advancement during his 19  
28 years of service to the State of Alabama, particularly by
